### Highlights:

Issues/Areas of Risk for HF/HSI in T&E were noted. Examples:

- HSI needs earlier involvement in IOT&E
- Lack of HSI inclusion and visibility on TEMP, tests
- HSI knowledge among T&E personnel needs to increase
- No templates for how to integrate HF/HSI into T&E
- Anthropometric updates needed

Most noted points:

- Members of the TAG are not aware of DoD documentation (ex: NAVSEAINST 3900.8A, PEOLMWISNT 4000.1, OPNAVINST 5310.23, etc) that dictate HSI policy and inclusion in DoD programs. They feel they don't have a way to force HSI/HF inclusion on DoD programs. Specifically, it was stated that HSIPs were no longer required. It would be beneficial to have a presentation that explained the major instructions that guide HSI policy to show programs that HSI must be involved.
- Methods of writing complete, measurable requirements are not well known. An informative brief to explain how to create metrics that can be measured and used in testing would be beneficial.
